CAMS MANUAL

STANDING / SPORTING REGULATIONS FOR WEST AUSTRALIAN OFF ROAD EVENTS.

The draft document has been in circulation for two months for contribution and comment. Panel members were given a copy of this for their perusal and comment on August 30th.

There was only one comment received in writing form the Nissan Car Club that included the following points:

- 3.1** -Clarify the point to provide info prior to the event. Including an entry list.
- 3.4** -Permission to start – Suggested that the point be amended to reflect prior to start each day
- 3.4c** – Eligibility Committee – NCC requested clarification that the WAORP role including eligibility.
- 6.3** – clarification of 1 hour vs 4 hrs
- 7** – Reconnaissance – clarification that you can leave for reconnaissance at any time during the reconnaissance window in your competition vehicle
- 12.3 b&c** – The Nissan Car Club requested the relevance
- 13.2** –Entire paragraph be simplified. Daniel Rogers suggested that this is a direct lift from the national regulations
- 14.9** – Suggested that the works automotive email needs to be removed
- 16.1** – Consistent with National regulations
- 17.2** – Confirmation that dimensions will be in 7.2 in 2007. Note Minimum sign sizes will be similar to Rally
- 4.6** – Judges of fact –Suggested that the Judges of Fact need to be nominated. To reduce the chance of an overzealous volunteer interfering.
- 12.4** – Owen Davies raised the issue of bonus point allocation for the final round. It was discussed that it may disadvantage the final round organisers to keep car numbers if a number of class championships were already decided. It was suggested that maybe an option would be to not drop a round. It was discussed that this would disadvantage anyone organising an event who could not drop the round when they were organising. The consensus is to leave it out.

Reformat numbering to remove 2 in WAORC specific regs

Jeremy Beck suggested that information should be sent to people with request for info back to panel direct
