CREW CIVIL LICENCE REQUIREMENTS/MINIMUM AGE

RATIONALE:

To ensure there can be no misinterpretation of the requirements for crews.

AUTHORITY:

These amendments were approved by the Australian Off Road Commission via email on 20th April 2007.

ACTION:

Amend Article 3.1(i) of the Off Road Standing Regulations as follows:

~~“(i) At least one member of each crew must hold a valid civil driver’s licence or be at least 18 years of age. Where the driver of an automobile is less than 18 years old and does not hold a current civil driver’s licence, he must be accompanied at all times while competing by a crew member, in the vehicle, who either holds a current civil driver’s licence or is not less than 18 years old.”~~
