



AUSTRALIAN OFF ROAD CHAMPIONSHIP REGISTRATION AND COMPETITION NUMBERS

Hello Off Road Competitors,

It is time to start thinking about renewing your Off Road Number and AORC registration for the 2008 season.

It is important to note that for this year there is an opening date of 10/12/2007 and *no* applications will be processed prior to this date so as to allow a fair time for all 2007 registered applicants to receive their mail.

Between 10th December 2007 and 29th February 2008 only numbers that were registered during 2007 shall be reallocated to AORC registered competitors that held that number during the 2007 season. Numbers will be reallocated upon receipt of a *fully* completed form with prompt payment.

After 29 February 2008, any number not applied for by its current holder will be become available to other applicants, and will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis.

The holding of a National Off Road number will constitute registration for the AORC, and therefore the crew can score points in the Championship. This registration *must* occur prior to the start of prologue for any round of the National Championship and there shall be no retrospective scoring of points for rounds entered, where the competitor was not registered prior to commencement of the prologue.

The registration package will include the following items, which other than the initial registration confirmation, will be distributed via email:

- Relevant CAMS Sporting and Technical Bulletins
- AORC Point Score
- CAMS Stickers
- Other CAMS information

The cost of this registration – and thus the competition number – will be \$50.00 including GST.

National numbers will in all cases take precedence over other numbers, at all levels of Off Road competition.

It is important to note that it is not a requirement to hold a number / be registered to enter an AORC event (any event for that matter), or be eligible for AORC event awards. For example, if you win the event or class, you will still win the trophy and appear in the results. This requirement relates only to the AORC point score, where non-registered competitors results will be disregarded for the purpose of points.

While not all holders will compete at the national level, much of the information that will be provided should still be of interest, and the fee will still apply. We re-iterate that there is no requirement for a number unless you want to score points in the



AORC, or you choose to have the benefit of guaranteeing your competition number at any event.

Registration fee **\$50.00 incl GST**

Please check your form carefully for correct details and complete all relevant parts of the form.

Remember that after 29 February 2008, any number not applied for by its current holder will be become free, and will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis.

No four (4) digit numbers for any class will be issued or re-issued at this time.

If you have not received confirmation of the number prior to the first AORC event in which you intend to compete, please ensure that you contact CAMS or lodge a provisional application with the Stewards of the event prior to the start of prologue.
