## 193. Suspension

**REFERENCE:**

**RATIONALE:**

The amendment clarifies several aspects including the subjective reference to 'grave offences' and some uncertainty about who can properly impose a penalty of suspension.

**AUTHORITY:**

*THIS AMENDMENT WAS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF CAMS AT A MEETING ON 11<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2008.*

**ACTION:****193. Suspension**

**(i)** A sentence of suspension may be pronounced only by **a State Council, a tribunal, AMSAC or the Board of CAMS** and shall be reserved for grave offences.

**(ii)** A sentence of suspension shall entail the loss of any right to take part in any capacity in any competition held within the territory of CAMS or under any FIA-approved agreement involving another ASN.

**(iii)** **Suspension shall render null and void an entry for any competition which may take place during the term of such suspension.**

**(iv)** Any CAMS licence holder who is suspended shall return his licence to CAMS immediately. ~~CAMS shall endorse the licence accordingly.~~ Any delay in returning a licence shall automatically result in the extension of the suspension by a period equal to the delay.

~~International licence suspension shall be implemented in accordance with the ISC.~~

**(v)** **CAMS shall endorse any licence which has been suspended accordingly.**

~~Suspension shall render null and void an entry for any competition which may take place during the term of such suspension.~~

**(vi)** When separate penalties of suspension are imposed they shall be cumulative in effect.

**(vii)** **International licence suspension shall be implemented in accordance with the ISC**
