## 186. Penalties

**REFERENCE:**CAMS Online Manual of Motor Sport, [www.camsmanual.com.au/ncr.asp](http://www.camsmanual.com.au/ncr.asp)**RATIONALE:**

This amendment allows officials to apply penalties that were not previously authorised.

**AUTHORITY:****ACTION:****186. Penalties**

Penalties which may be imposed are, in order of increasing severity:

- (i) reprimand;
- (ii) fine;
- (iii) **sundry** time penalty, **including time, starting position, stop/go and pit lane drive through;** (~~eg, Stop/Go, Pit Lane, drive through~~);
- (iv) exclusion;
- (v) suspension; and
- (vi) disqualification.

CAMS may approve Supplementary or Series regulations which specify fixed and other penalties and their method of application. The quantum of a fixed penalty may not be varied in any circumstances.
